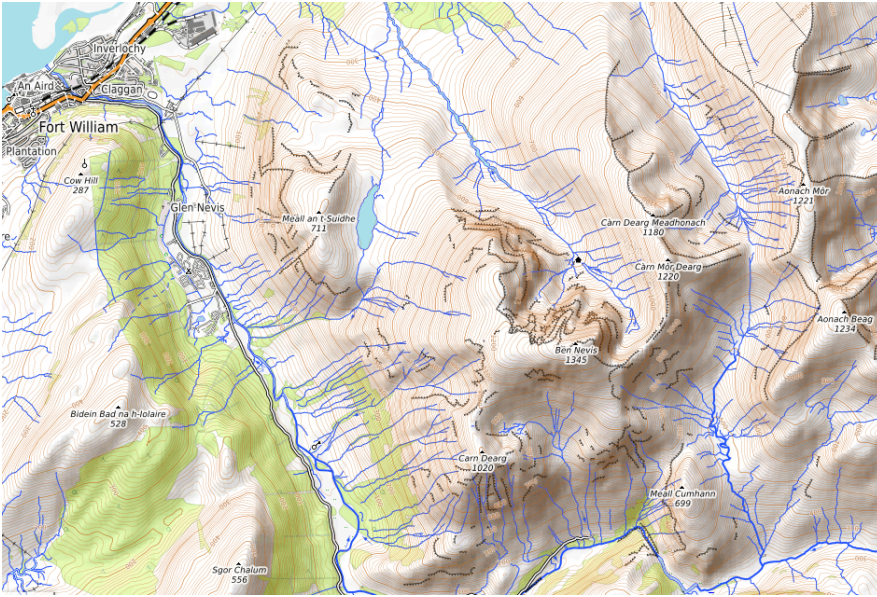


Ben Nevis – Mountain summits and surface water



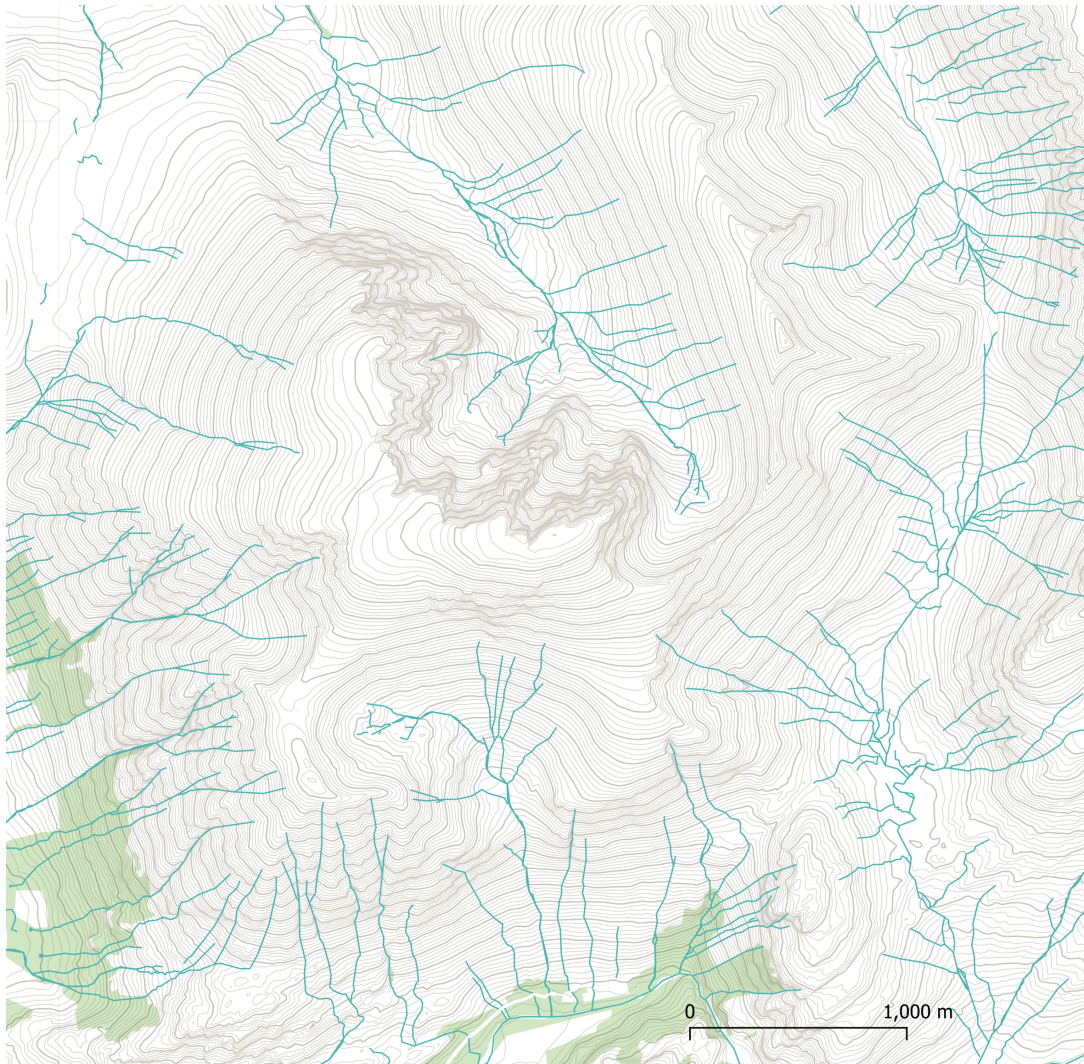
The map to the left shows Ben Nevis and the surrounding area.

Ben Nevis – 1345m
Carn Mor Dearg – 1220m
Carn Dearg Meadhonach - 1180m

Fun facts:

- *Carn Dearg Meadhonach is a ‘child summit’ of Carn Mor Dearg. The English translation of Carn Mor Dearg is ‘Big Red Peak’. Meadhonach means ‘Middle’ or ‘Moderate’.*
- *The summit of Ben Nevis is the collapsed dome of an ancient volcano.*
